Lower marks indicates very low attitude towards teaching profession. Percentage is used to show number level of attitudes towards teaching profession. The attitude scale towards teaching profession which was administered to 30 student teachers in the Tilak Collage of Education, Pune, were scored, on the basis of the responses obtained by them, student teachers are categorized into three groups for easy interpretation. The following table no.-1 shows student teachers scope, number of student teachers & the percentages of all teachers respondents attitude towards teaching profession.
